

A Tribute to Reverend Howard Shipp

He told me on numerous occasions that he valued growing up and playing with my father and uncle on Gaston Street. For those 2 years we served together, beginning in 2016, I grew to realize that when he spoke, he always had something you needed to hear. When some people speak, you feel the urge to add something to the conversation because they had forgotten or left something out. Not with Howard. When he finished there was nothing left to say. He covered it all! I feel so grateful to have had the opportunity to have known him and worked with him.

The other day I visited Rosedale Funeral Parlor's website where there is a tribute wall in which you can post messages. I was especially moved when I read Howard's granddaughter Chasity's post. I want to share it with you as it sums up what I feel about Howard.

"You may be gone from my sight but you are never gone from my heart. The many things you've done, all the times you were there, helps me to know deep down inside how much you really cared. It's hard to forget someone who gave you so much to remember. I will always keep the memories and I am blessed to have a grandpa (friend) like you." - Chasity Shipp
