Call Meeting to Order

Russell Wingfield called meeting to order.

Adoption of Agenda

Parcel ID # 16744 (Travis Property)

The gentleman who was taking care of the group of homes which consisted of 3 parcels passed away and one of the men who was a part of the homeowner's association started taking care of them. He is telling everyone that they do not have access to the land there. Rick advised projection lines go by property corners so his corner is way up towards the end of the cul-de-sac and it is his property. The city attorney has been spoken to regarding this matter. Russell advised owners did have access to the lake before the previous man passed away. Travis told him that the homeowners association was no longer a group and he is now in charge and he decided to disband the group.

Russell inquired about the ordinance regarding reflectors and possibly wanting to make some changes to it. Rick advised this ordinance is not state issued, just an ordinance set in place by the city. Aside from safety concerns, Rick is not sure why it was set in place. Russell stated that homeowners had some questions regarding what good it would be to have reflectors on their docks when they are unable to have running lights on their boats. The city gave out a lot of reflectors for free.

There is no plan to lower the lake level at this time.

Lake Clean Up Day

Russell advised that is a lot of interest in this and the homeowners will just probably set a date for that since it does not have to be approved by city council. They may want to do it before or after July 4 and gather trash up and take it to Northshore landing for the city to pick up.

Open Discussion/Commission Concerns

Russell advised that there are a lot more boats that seem to be participating in the Thursday night tournaments. Spawning season is also during the length of this event and he will mention this next year. To Rick's knowledge there have not been any fish dumped into the lake this year. Russell requested that they be dumped somewhere else maybe near NorthShore and Rick advised he would let them know.

Russell stated that Trip was supposed to speak with Stephen Fisher but there have been no updates regarding that. We are in a dead period which means no dredging that ends July 15. It started May 1. Russell mentioned there are inconsistency in some regulations.

July meeting will be held on Tuesday, July 11, 2023 due to the holiday on the previous week.

Rick advised we are applying for another grant that the city has to matching \$100,000 for and they have agreed it. Hoping to hear about that in September sometime.




